Please be advised that SCDHEC-OCRM has posted the following schedule of tentative dates for the beachfront jurisdictional line update. Find more info here: <http://www.scdhec.gov/beach/BeachfrontJurisdiction/index.htm>. We will provide updates and additional information throughout the process.

Tentative Dates

- **October 6, 2017:** Publication of proposed state beachfront jurisdictional line revisions; Notification of 30-day public comment period.
- **Oct. 23 - 27, 2017:** Public Hearings - Beaufort, Charleston and Grand Strand regions
- **Nov. 6, 2017:** Close of 30-day public comment period
- **Dec. 8, 2017:** Notification of State Adoption of Revised Beachfront Jurisdictional Lines
- **Dec. 27, 2017:** Implementation of revised state beachfront jurisdictional lines

“Once the location of the proposed new beachfront jurisdictional lines is determined by DHEC, a “line report” will be prepared documenting how the new line positions were established on each beach. The proposed jurisdictional lines and line reports will be made available for public review through the South Carolina Beachfront Jurisdiction Viewer (<https://gis.dhec.sc.gov/shoreline/>) and by appointment in DHEC-OCRM offices in Beaufort, Charleston and Myrtle Beach. A notification of a 30-day public comment period will be announced concurrent with the release of these products. Additionally, DHEC will host a series of regional public hearings. Instructions for submitting public comment will be provided online and at each regional public hearing.”
