Local beachfront management partners,

I am emailing to give a courtesy notice that OCRM will be releasing proposed beachfront jurisdictional lines tomorrow morning. All information regarding the proposed beachfront jurisdictional lines will be available at <http://www.scdhec.gov/beach/BeachfrontJurisdiction/> tomorrow morning.

Interested parties will also be able review the current and proposed jurisdictional lines by launching the S.C. Beachfront Jurisdiction Viewer: <https://gis.dhec.sc.gov/shoreline/>. The proposed beachfront jurisdictional lines will be viewable tomorrow morning. An accompanying "Line Report" has been prepared to document how the new proposed line positions were established on each beach. The proposed jurisdictional lines and Line Reports will both be available for public review through the South Carolina Beachfront Jurisdiction Viewer and by appointment in DHEC OCRM offices in Beaufort, Charleston and Myrtle Beach. A 30-day public comment period will commence on October 6, 2017, and will close on November 6, 2017. Instructions for submitting public comment are available through the S.C. Beachfront Jurisdiction Viewer and will be provided at each regional public hearing.

Public Hearings will afford the opportunity for the general public to view the proposed state beachfront jurisdictional lines during the open public comment period. Regional Public Hearings are scheduled as follows:

Current state beachfront jurisdictional lines will remain in effect until revised lines are established and adopted in final form. As required by statute, DHEC will complete its revision process prior to December 31, 2017. However, proposed jurisdictional lines are subject to the administrative appeals process.
