John W. (Billy) McCord is a Wildlife Biologist in the Marine Resources Division, SC Department of Natural Resources. He specializes in Coastal Zone ecology and natural history with particular focus on coastal islands. He is active in public outreach for DNR, providing talks and consultation to schools and community groups with an interest in ecology and the natural environment.

This presentation is especially relevant to Sullivan's Island Elementary, one of two schools on the beach in the USA, as it applies to become a partial magnet school with an educational emphasis on marine and environmental science. Principal Susan King will explain how this will fit into a magnet curriculum. This topic is also highly relevant to the Town of Sullivan's Island which is developing an improved management plan for 90+ acres of accreted beach-front land held in protected Land Trust.
